Generally, each sin is the ground work for a larger one. On this issue, the Qur'an states:

"Not so; whose earns evil, and is encompassed by his transgression -- those are the inhabitants of the Fire; there they shall dwell forever."2

If the curtain of modesty is torn, sinning becomes easy. That's why in Dua-e-Kumail we read:

Oh God... please forgive me for those sins I have committed that tear the curtain of chastity and purity.
