## On Turnips (Al-Saljam)

Abu Bakr Muhammad b. al-Huraysh narrated from Muhammad b. 'Isa from 'Ali b. Musayyib from al-'Abd al-Salih [Musa al-Kazim], peace be upon him, that he said: "Eat turnips (*al-lift*), that is *al-saljam*, for there is not one who has a strain of leprosy (*lirq al-min al-judham*) but that the eating of turnips (*al-saljam*) dissolves it." He ['Ali b. Musayyib] asked: "Raw or cooked?" He replied: "Both".

From Abu Ja'far, peace be upon him, that he said: "There is no creature who has in him a strain of leprosy but that it is dissolved by [eating] turnips (*al-saljam*)."
