Those Who were Executed

After dominating over the people of Medina, Muslim b. 'Uqba summoned some of the more influential and well-known figures of Medina and sentenced them to death upon special hearings.

These hearings are unique in early Islamic history as Muslim b. 'Uqba being the conquerer and aggressor, wanted the ones whom he had summoned to swear allegiance to him as the slaves and servants of Yazed! 1145

The more well-known figures executed in this tragic event include: Ab Bakr b. 'Abd All h Ja'far b. Ab Telib2; two sons of Zaynab, daughter of Umm Salama3; Ab Bakr b. 'Ubayd All h b. 'Abd All h b. 'Umar b. al-Khatt b4; Ma'qal b. San (One of the Prophet's (s) standard bearer in the conquest of Mecca)5; Fadl b. 'Abb b b. Rab a b. Herith b. 'Abd al-Muttalib33; Ab Sa' d Khudr (a companion of the Prophet (s) who was in the Prophet's company in twelve expeditions)6; 'Abd All b b. Mut 7 (a commander of the Medinans who escaped that event, joined Ibn Zubayr, and executed by Hajj 1).

Apart from these, there were several other people who were killed under the pretext of accompanying or helping the people of Medina and their names too are recorded in historical sources.8152

Partial list of the names of males killed in the Tragedy of Harrah

It is obvious that the actual number of the people who were killed in the tragedy of Harrah is definitely far more than what is mentioned in the history books. What follows below is the list of names of those killed that is reported by historians. In addition, the list doesn't include the names of the dead females and children, which was higher than those of males killed in this tragedy.

'Abd All hb. Hanzala

'Abd All®h b. Hanzala b. al-Ghas® b. Ab® ®mir b. R®hib - 'Abd 'Amr b. Sayf® b. Nu'm®n b. M®lik b. Amat b. Dubay'at b. Zayd b. M®lik b. 'Awf b. 'Amr b. 'Awf b. M®lik b. Aws20 - was the commander-in-chief of the Medinan forces. He was among the dignitaries of T®bi®n (successors of the Prophet's companions)21 and one of the few warriors who was famous for his gallantry.22 His mother's name was Jam®la - daughter of 'Abd All®h b. Ubayy b. Sall®l. The reason why 'Abd All®h's father was called Ghas®l al-Mal®ika is that Hanzala decided to participate in the battle of Uhud. Their marriage took place 32 months after Hijra and the early morning after he consummated his marriage with his wife, Hanzala had to participate in the battle of Uhud and he was martyred on the same day without anytime to perform obligatory ritual ablution. According to Prophet (s), the angels gave him ritual ablution (ghus1).23 For this reason, Hanzala was known as Ghas®l al-Mal®ika. Jam®la gave birth to 'Abd All®h nine months after the martyrdom of Hanzala and 'Abd All®h was seven years old at the time of the Prophet's (s) demise.46 He had met the Prophet (s) and narrated traditions from His Holiness.24 He was killed as a martyr along with eight of his children due to the sword stroke of one of the Syrian soldiers21 and thus the life of this noble man and eminent companion of the Prophet (s) came to an end.

Muhammad b. 'Amr b. Hazm

Muhammad b. 'Amr b. Hazm b. Lawdhin b. 'Amr b. Awf b. Ghanm b. Milk b. Najjir was nicknamed as Abi 'Abd al-Malik. His mother, 'Amra, was the daughter of 'Abd Allih b. Hirith b. Jammiz from Bani Hubila who was among the allies of Bani Si'id.25 He was born in a place called Najrin in the 10th year

after Hijra. 26 His father had been appointed as the governor of that place. Muhammad b. 'Amr b. Hazm was among the nobles of the biten. 27 He was a dignified man from whom some traditions have been narrated. On the day of Harrah, he said prayers while he was seriously injured. He was finally martyred in the battle of Harrah in 63 A.H. (682 C.E.). In Medina and Baghdad some of his descendents had survived.

Muhammad b. Ubayy

Muhammad b. Ubayy b. Ka'b b. Qays b. 'Ubayd b. Mu'nwiyah b. 'Amr b. Mnlik b. Najjnr was nicknamed as Abn Ma'ndh. He was born in the time of the Prophet (s). His mother, Umm al-Tufayl, was the daughter of Tufayl b. 'Amr b. Mundhar b. Subay' b. 'Abd Nuham from Daws tribe. He was an eminent scholar of hadnth and a few traditions have also been transmitted from him. He was killed in the battle of Harrah in 63 A.H. (682 C.E.)28172

Suwayd b. 'Uwaym

The mother of Suwayd b. 'Uwaym b. S\(\mathbb{I}\) ish b. Qays b. Nu'm\(\mathbb{I}\)n b. Yaz\(\mathbb{I}\)d b. Umayyah Um\(\mathbb{I}\)ma, was the daughter of Bukayr b. Tha'laba, a descendant of Ban\(\mathbb{I}\) Ghadab b. Jushm b. Jazraj. He was killed on the day of Harrah in 63 A.H. (682 C.E.)29173

Ayy b b. Bash r

Ayy®b b. Bash®r b. Sa'd b. Nu'm®n b. Akk®l b. Lawdh®n b. H®rith b. Umayyah b. Mu'®wiyah b. M®lik b. 'Awf b. 'Awf, was from the *Ans®rs* and from the Khazraj tribe. His nickname was Ab® Sulaym®n. He was born in the time of the Prophet (s). He participated in the battle of Harrah and received many injuries, and after two years died of the injuries at the age of 75.30174

'Ubbed and Thebit, Sons of Tamem

'Umayr b. Sa'd

'Umayr b. Sa'd and 'Amr b. Sa'd's brother were of the same mother. These two brothers were killed on the day of Harrah.38182

Ibrehem b. Nu'aym

Ibrehem b. Nu'aym b. Nahem b. 'Abd Alleh b. Ased b. 'Abd 'Awf b. 'Ubayd b. 'Uwayj 'Adeyy b. Ka'b was one of the commanders on the day of Harrah and was killed on the same day.39183

'Abd al-Rahm®n b. Huytab

'Abd al-Rahmen b. Hutyab b. 'Abd al-'Uzze b. Abe Qays b. 'Abd Wadd b. Nasr b. Melik b. Hisl b. 'Emir b. Lu'ayy's mother, Anesa, was Hafs b. Ahnaf from Bane 'Emir b. Luwayy's tribe. 'Abd al-Rahmen was killed on the day of Harrah in Dhu'l Hijja, in 63 A.H.41

Ja'far b. 'Abd Allsh

Ja'far b. 'Abd All
h b. Buhayna was killed on the day of Harrah. 42 Buhayna, Umm 'Abd All
h, was Arat's daughter.

'Abd Allsh b. 'Utba

'Abd Alleh b. 'Utba b. Ghazwen b. Jebir b. Naseb b. Wuhayb b. Zayd b. Melik b. 'Abd 'Awf b. Herith b. Mezin b. Manser b. 'Ikrama b. Hasafa b. 'Aylen b. Mudar, was killed on the day of Harrah.43187

'Abd All®h b. Muhammad b. Ab® Bakr, was a slave girl named S®da. 'Abd All®h was killed on the day of Harrah.44188

'Ab® Sa®d b. 'Abd al-Rahm®n b. H®rith b. Hish®m b. Mughayra's mother, Umm Rasan, was the daughter of H®rith b. 'Abd All®h b. Husayn from the Ban® H®rith b. Kab tribe. Ab® Sa®d was killed on the day of Harrah.45

'Um®ra b. Suhab b. San®n b. M®lik, was killed on the day of Harrah.49

'Abd al-Rahmen b. 'Abd Alleh

'Abd al-Rahmen b. 'Abd Alleh b. Khubayb b. Yasef b. 'Inabat b. 'Amr b. Khudayj b. 'emir b. Jusham b. Herith b. Khazraj was killed on the day of Harrah. 54 His mother was 'Awna, daughter (of Abe Mased 'Uqba b. 'Amr) from Bane Jidera.

'Abd al-Rahmen b. Abe Quteda

'Abd al-Rahmen b. Abe Qatedat b. Rab'e b. Baldhama was killed on the day of Harrah. 55 His mother, Sulefa, was daughter of Bare' b. Ma'rer from Bane Salma tribe.

Yazgd b. Abg al-Yasar

Yazīd b. Abī al-Yasar (Ka'b b. 'Amr b. 'Abbīd b. 'Amr b. Sawīd) from Banī Salma was from Khazraj tribe. He was killed on the day of Harrah.56
